SPRING FLOOD PROTECTION TIPS



OUTSIDE YOUR HOME

- Remove debris from eaves troughs and downspouts
- Extend downspouts at least 6' away from foundation
- Seal cracks and gaps in basement windows, doors and foundation

INSIDE YOUR HOME

- Test sump pump, backup battery and alarm
- Clean backwater valve and test alarm
- Remove any items blocking the floor drain

SUMMER FLOOD PROTECTION TIPS



- Extend downspouts at least 6' (2m) away from foundation
- Test your sump pump and backup battery

- Clear snow from nearest catch basin

- Check your sump pump and backup battery
- Check your backwater valve
- Remove the most valuable items from your basement
